Concrete Committee was held CICHE-JSCE Joint seminar on Concrete Engineering in Taiwan, 2004 and KSCE (Korean Society of Civil Engineers)-JSCE Joint seminar on Durability of Concrete Structures in Korea, 2003.

The next joint seminar will be held in Vietnam in 2006. The seminar was funded by the Yoshida Award Selection Committee and was partially funded by the International Activities Committee, JSCE.

The seminar began with the opening speech by Dr.Ganzorig, President of MACE (Mongolian Association of Civil Engineers), followed by salutations from the Vice-Minister of Ministry of Construction in Mongolia, Prof. Jenn-Chuan Chern, President of CICHE and Prof. Tamon Ueda, Hokkaido University. After Prof. Ueda ended his speech, he presented the English version of the latest JSCE Standard Specifications for Concrete Structures, "Structural Performance Verification", "Maintenance" and "Seismic Performance Verification" to MACE.

There were five presentations from JSCE and three presentations from CICHE. About 200 Mongolian engineers attended the seminar. The presentation titles are as follows.
