Introduction to Contributors

1. Author: Journal JGEE accepts papers submitted by non-JSCE members.
2. Papers submission: Paper should be submitted to The Editorial Committee of Journal of Global Environment Engineering (JGEE).
3. Deadline: Receive at anytime. Note, however, that a discussion paper should be submitted within 6 months of the publication of the papers it is addressing.
4. Paper categories: Only papers that have not been published elsewhere are considered. Please refer to the definitions of categories and contents mentioned below.

1. Research papers:

Papers dealing with theoretical/ empirical studies or technological achievement, or showing integrated insights into these. Must have originality and complete structures as research papers.

2. Technical note report

- 1) Articles that cover new research/ technological findings and are not necessarily written in a complete structure as Research Papers.
- 2) Articles raising questions or presenting tentative assumptions, or giving opinions on these.
- 3) Articles complimenting or giving corrections to already published theses/reports.
- 4) Test/Measurement data or statistical/schematic diagrams that can be used in researches and technological improvements.

3. Discussion papers

- 1) Research/ Technological findings related to already published papers in JGEE.
- 2) Opinions or questions on already published papers in JGEE.

5. Scope of the journal

1) Physical aspects of global environmental problems:

Climatic change, sea level rise, destruction of the ozone layer, acid precipitation, international water disputes, marine pollution, transboundary movement of hazardous wastes, desertification, species extinction, and conservation of historical and cultural inheritances.

2) Socio-economic aspects of global environmental problems:

Environmental issues in developing countries, injurious impacts of global environmental change of developing countries and minority groups, double standard, deportation of environment-disruptive industries to developing countries, response strategies in developed countries, problems relating to vulnerability of government and economy in developing countries, depletion of natural and energy resources, and civil engineering technologies in developing countries.

6. Reviewing Procedure

- (i) Papers are peer-reviewed by the editorial committee of JGEE.
- (ii) The Committee reviews papers and determines eligibility for publication. The Committee may request the author for necessary revision.
- (iii) The Committee completes all reviewing process within 3 months after the submission of the paper.
- (iv) If the Committee does not receive the revised manuscript from the author within 3 weeks after the request of revision, the paper is treated as rejected.

7. How to Prepare a Manuscript

- (1) Paper must be fully elaborated before submission.
- (2) Paper should be written in English and must not exceed 12 pages.
- (3) **Send paper in PDF format to the address in the bottom. Paper should include a title, author's name/names, department and contact information.**
- (4) The Manuscript should be prepared according to the JGEE paper format with referring to the Web page. (<http://www.jsce.or.jp/committee/global/JGEE-eng.htm>)

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
