Technical Program

The technical program will be run in three parallel sessions. The number of sessions may be increased if the number of accepted abstracts is more than expected.

Organized sessions

We are planning to have special organized sessions. If you wish to plan one of these sessions, please contact coastalstructures@ce-ocean.sakura.ne.jp with the session title, paper titles and authors by October 15, 2010. Each session consists of 4-5 papers. If your proposal is accepted by the organizing committee, the abstracts will be due by December 20, 2010.

Special Poster Session

The poster presentation will be held as a special session of **Summary of Coastal Projects.** We invite papers related not only to recent projects, but also to major projects from the past, such as storm surge defenses, deepwater ports, offshore airports, shore protection, floating structures, and submerged tunnels, etc.

Abstract Submission

Prospective authors are invited to submit papers dealing with the Conference subjects. Each abstract is limited to two pages and should be submitted by December 20, 2010. Abstracts must be written in English and the contents should not have been previously published or presented. Papers for the poster session can be review papers. Papers for both oral presentation and poster session will be published in the Conference Proceedings. Abstracts must be electronically submitted, preferably in Adobe pdf format, through the Conference Web site

www.jsce.or.jp/committee/ocean/coastalstructures/

from which the MS-Word abstract template or PDF example can be downloaded. File size should not exceed 2 MB. Abstracts must include the names and email addresses of all authors. An individual may not be the first author or presenter of more than one accepted paper.

Commitment to Attend

Proposing authors must recognize that submission of an abstract is, if accepted, a commitment to attend the Conference, as well as to present and complete the paper.

Registration

Registration on the web will be opened on March 1, 2011. Hotel reservation will be available at the same page as the online registration.

Conference Venue

The conference will be held in Yokohama, which is the second largest city in Japan. It lies next to Tokyo in the south on the periphery of Tokyo Bay and is a major commercial hub of the Greater Tokyo Area. Yokohama has developed rapidly as Japan's prominent port city following the end of Japan's relative isolation in 1859.

The conference will be held at Yokohama Port-Opening Memorial Hall.
